Aside from the above, Laws and Regulations on Chinese Medicine Administration, the names and time of the relevant existing laws on Chinese medicine administration and management, physicians or

herbal specialists examinations, Chinese medicine nursing, National Health Insurance, Chinese medicine outpatient payment system, etc. are listed. In the data on Chinese Medical Organizations, physicians or herbal specialists

on Chinese medicine associations and societies specialized in Chinese Medicine at all levels in Taiwan have been made available. As to the part of "Chinese Medical Clinic Training" , a whole construction for CCMP2002-2008 program and a new adds for training physicians and specialists sponsored by the Chinese medicine organizations are also presented here in general. Finally, in the Relevant Statistics on the Administration of Chinese Medicine and Relevant Statistics on National Health Insurance, data on the relevant Chinese medical facilities, medical manpower, medical service analysis, National Health Insurance system, service institutions, medical service payment procedures, etc. have also been compiled herewith.

The indicators here have surveyed all the relevant administrations and statistics on Chinese medicine and pharmacy, and have compiled

them into a book as a reference tool so that the users can obtain all the informations they require in a short time.
